### \* Conflict:

A condition caused by a real or imagined conflict of needs, values, and interests. The conflict can be internal personal or external between individuals.

Conflict as a concept helps explain many aspects of social life, such as social difference, conflict of interests and wars between individuals, groups or organizations. In political terms, conflict can refer to wars, revolutions, or struggles, which may involve the use of force as in armed conflict. Conflicts in social settings can lead to tensions when there is no peaceful solution to them or how to deal with them.

Conflict may amount to violence, but, as Graham Evans and Jeffrey Newenham say, it may have positive functions; It works in particular to enhance cohesion between groups and strengthen the leadership position.

And common in conflict: "when two or more parties perceive conflicting goals and seek to weaken the capabilities of the other to reach the goal."

\* History of the conflict:

The idea of a clash of civilizations is an idea that the West came to us, forgetting that human civilization is one that relied in its composition on the findings of nations and peoples in various fields of life, which depended in its foundation on three axes “production, accumulation, and then wealth” in thought, agriculture, trade, industry and other components of nature. Humanity and on these data built human civilization. The clash of civilizations is a form of dialogue between cultures as a result of their multiplicity, meaning that human civilization passed through five stages or regimes that were dominant over the idea and its ruling ideology and the main component of its history and culture over the various ages, which eventually led to a terrible conflict that reached the utmost levels of tyranny and human tyranny.

\* Generations of conflict wars:

- The first generation began after the confrontations between the colonial countries and the Ottoman Empire, which was called in its last days the sick man of Europe...

- The second generation, it appeared in close periods of time, during the First World War, where the second generation wars are known as that type of war that is characterized by preemptive strikes with artillery and aircraft...

- The third generation, it was developed by German forces in the First World War as well, and the third generation wars do not depend on the power of arms, as much as they depend on the elements of speed, surprise, and mental manipulation of the opponent, seeking to reach the depth of the enemy and destroying it from within, and planting spies, rather than clashing. And the third generation wars did not only lead to a change in war tactics, but also aimed at changing the military culture as well, as individual initiatives became more important than blind obedience and the implementation of orders.

Fourth generation: It focuses on the cultural and cognitive factor of the enemy's strengths, to turn them into weaknesses that are easy to attack, and cause heavy losses.

The fifth generation: It expresses a conflict in which several areas of conventional wars are employed, in addition to economic, informational, cyber and other tools, and it mixes traditional and non-traditional tactics and depends on building alliances that include actors from the auxiliary countries.

These are wars without restrictions, in which there are no prohibitions, and they are not limited to countries, but extend to societies, and may resort to implementing the idea of a Chinese military leader,

who says that the greatest degree of skill is “smashing the enemy without fighting”, and through which it is also difficult to determine the identity The party that wages war.

These wars are based on common interests rather than ideological or national goals, and may postpone their military goals in favor of relying on economic and information wars and building broader alliances with the aim of overthrowing the target country.

The Sixth Generation: The first to use the term sixth-generation wars, the Russian General Vladimir Slipchenko, when he told the whole world that conventional wars are outdated, and that all wars after that will be managed with smart systems, and will reap smart results as well.

These wars work to recruit the entire Internet and create gangs whose mission is to defraud, steal identities and engage in criminal operations, wars that combine terrorism and remote management.

Seventh-generation wars: mainly targeting the human mind to control it by many different means that can be used, including, but not limited to, the network of satellites spread in the orbits of the Earth, whose numbers are estimated in the millions, and whose superior capabilities actually reach remote control as known. With human control chips or “RFID”, it has already been voluntarily tested on about two billion people by the American intelligence services “CIA”, and it has been so successful that the United States plans to circulate it according to the information available to specialists in this regard.. It is also from These satellites are scheduled to share with the Echelon system for spying around the world and many other modern piracy projects, such as bio-hacking or “Bio-Hack”, and therefore we are already facing new types of wars that some specialists called the term contactless wars, which have begun to spread. And the application in recent years, and then it seems that the new generations of wars will retreat through which tactical and strategic plans and change many combat concepts, including the concepts of loss, gain or victory. The new Yale, according to what the strategists said, will depend in eliminating the political systems on the peoples of the country themselves by igniting internal revolutions that bring about change without any direct interventions, as the concepts and contents of military arts change to keep pace with the massive and highly intelligent information revolution and development that the world is witnessing.

A few years ago, a Washington Post journalist called one of these war systems the “Space Jinn System” because it relied on highly developed technologies that resemble pure fantasy, and relies on about half a million small satellites scattered around the Earth. \* The world order in the shadow of conflict:

Which in turn led to the emergence of a new level of conflict represented in the international conflict.

- The Third World System: It is based in fact on the movement of trade. Global trade created surplus funds, created wealth, opened geographical discoveries, discovered continents and achieved many things, and this is a global system in which the printing press, the map, and the compass appeared... and these were its tools..

The Fourth World Order: “The Age of Revolutions,” in which the American colonies began to appear when South America had a surplus of wealth, and a new era of liberation began. In this era, great human revolutions took place, from the first independence revolution in America, the Great French Revolution, the end of the Barmon era and the advent of the Barmon era. The United States took every place in Europe and employed it in technologies, then presented the model of the global system in which we are still. A renewed world order is coming, in the last stage of its formation, looming from East Asia, such as China and others...

\* a summary:

At the outset, it is necessary to stand, meditate, read and analyze, at the "media bomb" that was carried by the statements of the US Secretary of Defense (Lloyd Austin) on the last day of April that the next major war will be "very different".

In his first major policy speech, he said that the United States should prepare for a possible future conflict not so much like the "old wars" that "used up" the Department of Defense for so long.

The messages carried by the minister's speech could not hide its implications. Austin called for mobilizing technological progress and improving the integration of military operations globally in order to "understand faster, make decisions faster, act faster" and added that "the way we will fight in war The next major battle will look completely different from the way we fought in previous wars."

They are also broad and ambiguous future goals for the Pentagon leadership under President Joe Biden.

The concept of wars has changed with the beginning of the millennium, as the world has witnessed in the past years atypical wars, such as electronic and cyber piracy.

This is what some lawmakers in Congress addressed in their statements about hacking the electronic servers of US government interests last year, as well as what the world witnessed in terms of biological and economic warfare, as is the case with China.

Therefore, there is no doubt that the next American wars will be based on a new strategy in armaments, which is a mixture of technology, capabilities and how to implement them.

Minister Austin's words, even if he did not refer to the American military retreat that occurred since the era of former President Barack Obama and before him George Bush, by interfering in Iraq and Afghanistan and shaking America's image after the events of September 11, pointed out that the battles in Iraq and Afghanistan did not compensate for the defeat that the United States received. It indicates an underlying conviction that.

Today, the American strategy implemented by the Pentagon appears to be based on the premise that America must withdraw its forces and preserve its strategic military stockpile, because the next American war is a war of technology, science and competition over who can control the course of things globally. It is also a war based on deterrence and relies on a mixture of computer technology. And what is known as "quantum physics" and space, or what is known as "remote deterrence." In an easier way, it can be said that the war here will not be based on conflict, conflict and confrontation on the ground, but rather on the use of technology and space as a tool for deterrence.

It is the challenge of wars with technology that is far from direct confrontation.

There does not appear on the immediate horizon to indicate America's willingness to back down from its quest to remain in a position of leadership in the world, even if that is not possible...

In addition, the policies and international relations in the light of the new international system based on unipolarity do not affect civilization as much as the state clearly and effectively, which makes policies that serve and facilitate the interests of states in order to achieve their strategic goals.

Here is the essence of the conflict today, which depends on the politics of interests, power and control, and not on human values and principles.

This means, that the conflict will not end and the wars will remain, and if the patterns, methods, forms, elements, capabilities and capabilities differ, the goals remain the same, leadership and control...

But what is happening today on the global scene, in terms of American defeat and retreat to the unilateralism of the world, in the face of various wars and counter-alliances, loss of control and weakness of the client, agent and ally, has led to the amputation of his arm in more than one place in the world, especially in the Middle East, and this is what Reflected on the balance of power and deterrence, in favor of its opponents.

At the same time with America's preoccupation with wars, China was seizing the time to build its economic and technological empire and prepare its numbered financial system, to conquer the world after signing agreements with more than 100 countries to launch its global investment project, the Silk Road...

This is what forced America to adopt new policies and plans and change the strategy of the conflict from the position of attack to the position of defense in the face of the tide coming to it from the east of the world, and the biggest and most dangerous competitor for its leadership, rather the strongly

contested and ahead of it in global leadership, in light of intense competition To dominate the world's markets...

They are the various striking, cold and soft wars in the light of the clash of civilizations, for which humanity has paid the price of major humanitarian, economic and social crises and problems, which led to a failure in the concepts and systems of democracy, which was reflected on the American society, which is threatened, shaken and destined to fall from within...

It is the unrivaled capitalism in this era, but it is renewable and transformed from capital (petro dollars) to (data capitalism and digital currencies), which will be circulated by the world's leaders in the near time, in light of an iron global system (artificial intelligence, robots and computers).. .
